



GSE ON CELLPHONE USE (NEW RULES)



Besides the benefits of the latest technology to users, cell phones play a vital role in our life. The school recognizes the need for communication between the students and the parents especially during emergency cases.

A Grade School Judenite is allowed to bring his/her cell phones to school provided he/she is a responsible user. The cell phone should be turned off before the start of each class. He/She can only turn it on during free time and dismissal time. In case of emergency, he/she may use the cell phone provided he/she asks the permission of his/her teacher.

However, when the cell phone rings/beeps during class hours the teacher will:

1st Offense

- a. confiscate the cell phone.
- b. surrender the cell phone to the Head Teacher.
- c. inform the parents through the assignment notebook or Conduct Profile.

Parents can claim the cell phone from the Head Teacher.

2nd Offense

- a. confiscate the cell phone.
- b. surrender the cell phone to the Head Teacher.
- c. inform the parents thru the assignment notebook or conduct profile.

Parents can claim the cell phone AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR FROM THE PREFECT OF DISCIPLINE.
